Household Income Limitation: \$54,000

Required Documents:

- Valid Photo ID (required for ALL taxpayers)
- Social Security Card or ITIN number for all family members on the return
- All W-2 Forms (earning statements) from every employer you worked for during 2016
- Forms 1099 for any retirement income, interest income or dividend income received during 2016.
- Child care expenses: total of payments made and the name, address and Employer Identification Number (EIN) or Social Security number of the provider
- Mortgage interest statements from lender for 2016 and proof of real estate and excise taxes paid in 2016
- Form 1098 (tuition payment statement) for each household member who attended college in 2016 and the total amount of student loan interest you may have paid
- Total rent paid in 2016 and landlord or rental agent's name and address
- Your checkbook or bank statement if you want to direct deposit your refund
- Proof of medical insurance for all parties on the return (for both Federal & MA return) 1099HC for private insurance or health care card for government sponsored plans
- 1095-A for health insurance purchased through HealthCare.gov or the State Marketplace.
- Copy of last year's income tax return would also be helpful
